IMED Biotech Unit, AstraZeneca

Professor Stephen Rennard completed undergraduate training in Folklore and Mythology at Harvard College, obtained his MD degree from Baylor College of Medicine, trained in Internal Medicine at Washington University and then did research and Pulmonary training at the National Institutes of Health. He was Chief of the Pulmonary Division at University of Nebraska Medical Center, Omaha, from 1984 until 1997 and remains the Richard and Margaret Larson Research Professor at the University. His research has focused on mechanisms of tissue remodeling and repair, and clinical studies particularly related to chronic obstructive pulmonary disease and smoking cessations. In August 2015, he joined AstraZeneca as Chief Clinician Scientist in the Clinical Discovery Unit of Early Clinical Development and became head of that Unit in 2016. Stephen was appointed Head of IMED Early Clinical Development in November 2017.
